

Valuable Comments about Reading (Some ideas and examples)

- Joe read enthusiastically and understood the story.
- Joe was able to tell me about the book after we read.
- Fluent and confident and enjoying the book.
- Paula used her phonics knowledge to read some words.
- Recognised the exclamation mark! And full stop!
- The tools on page 8 helped us to explore the story further.
- Confused the 'b' and 'd' sound at the beginning/end of the word but self corrected when he realised it didn't

make sense. Well done!

- Was mistaking 'was' and 'saw'
- Loved the pictures and we enjoyed talking about them.
- She found the word 'after' very tricky.
- Wow! The first story read to the end without any help.
- She is beginning to talk about the book.
- We looked at the title and discussed what Mary thought the book was about.
- Mary did not think that the title fit the book when we read the story.
- Read at a steady pace.
- I am delighted with how his/her reading is improving.
- Tim noticed that the picture on the front of the book was colour unlike the ones inside the book.
- Mary predicted what she thought would happen.
- Mary did not like the ending of the book and she could tell me why.
