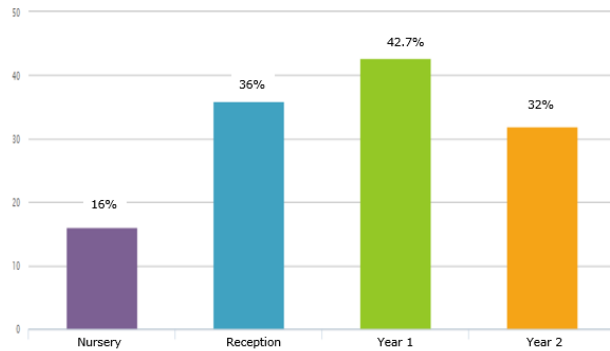
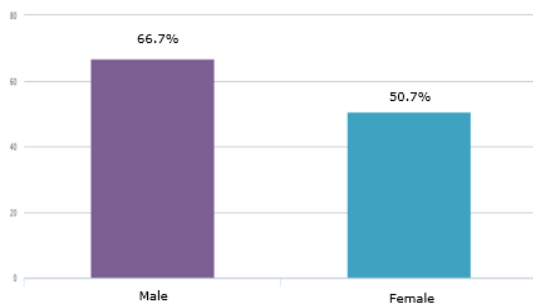

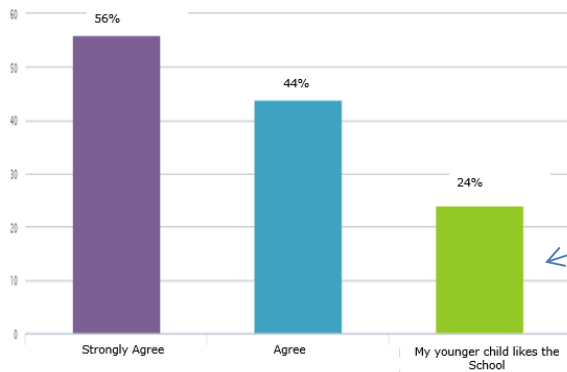

## 2. Please tell us the gender of your child/children.

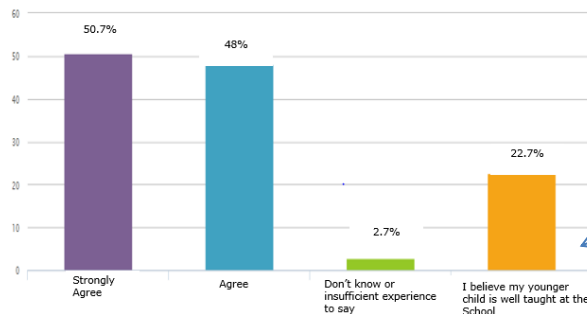


## 3. My older child likes the School

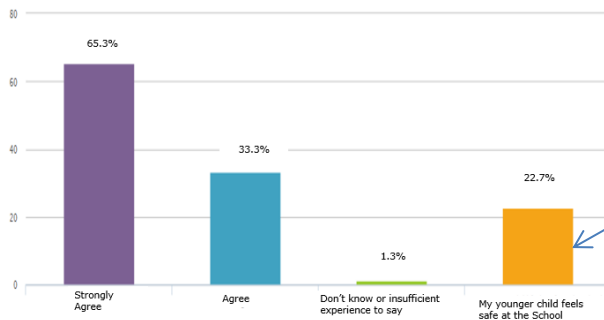

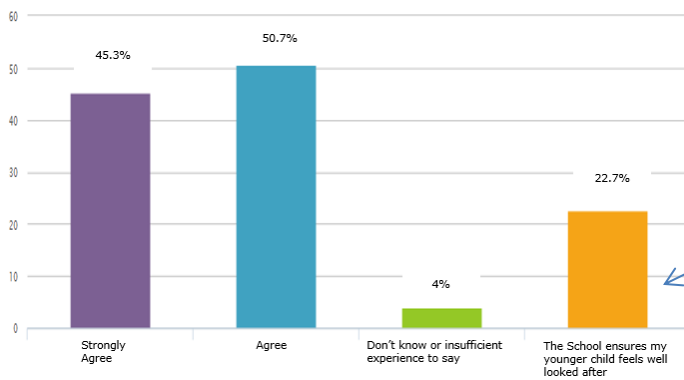

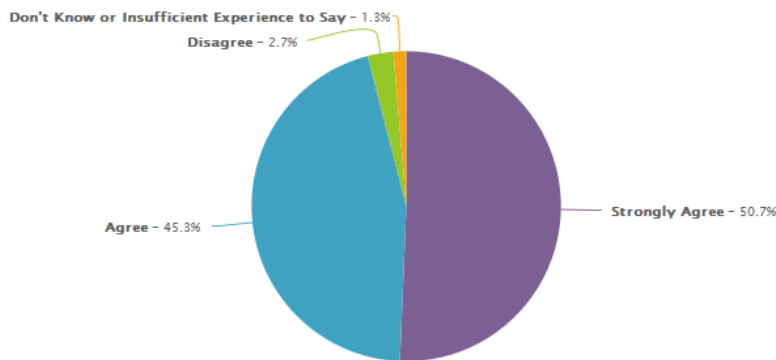

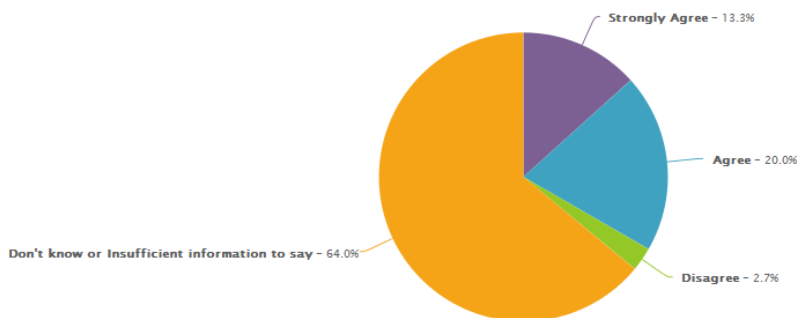

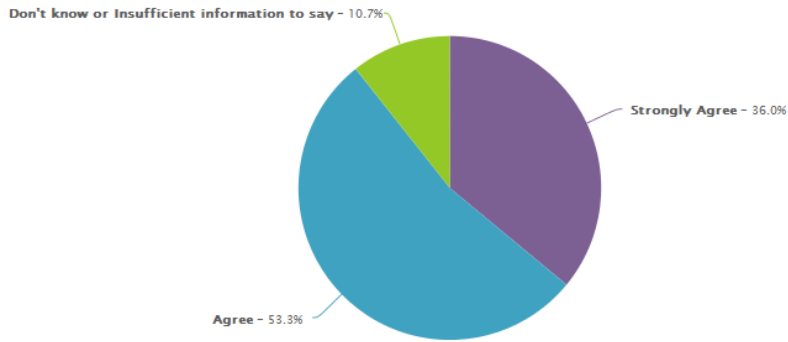

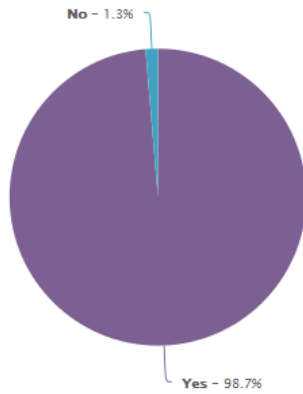

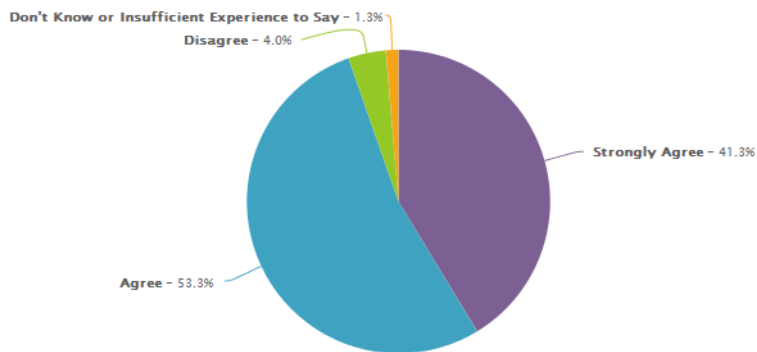

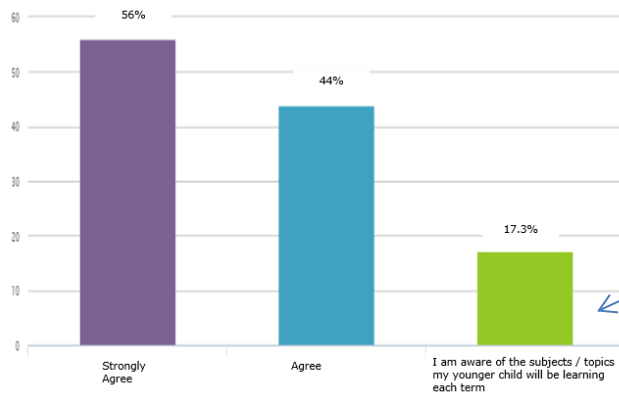

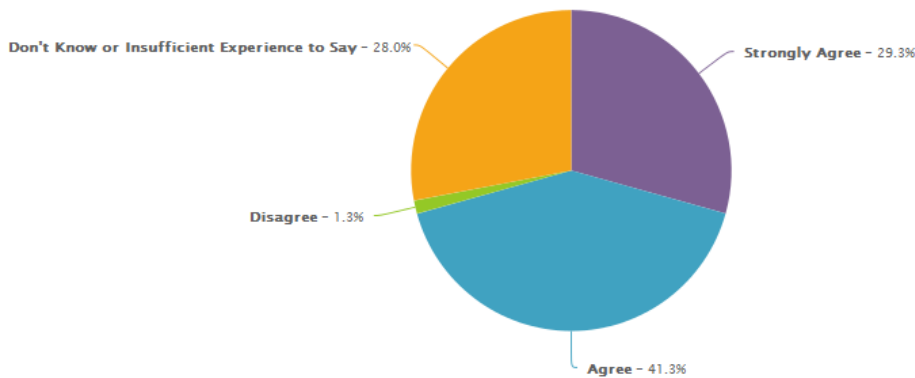

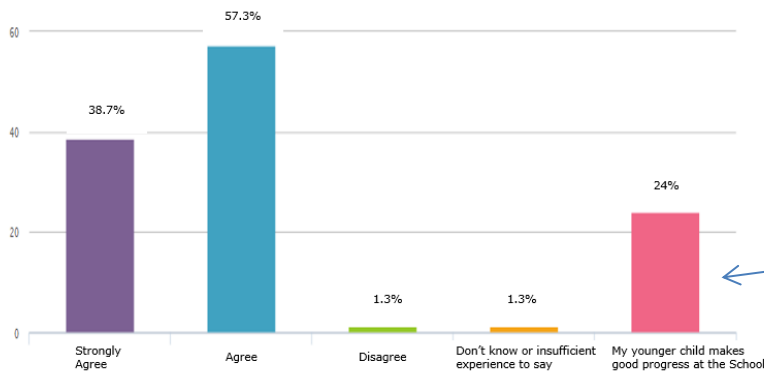


*I am aware of the subjects / topics my younger child will be learning each term*

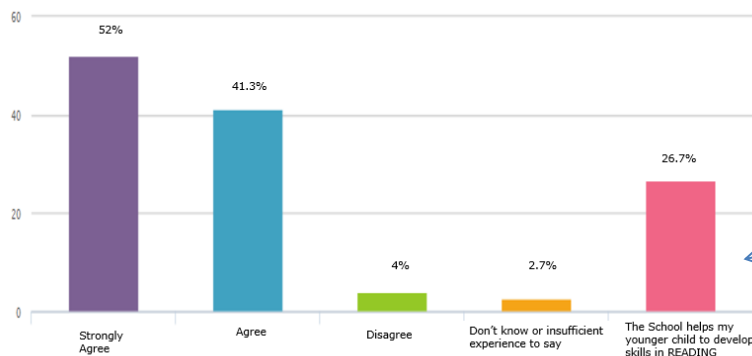

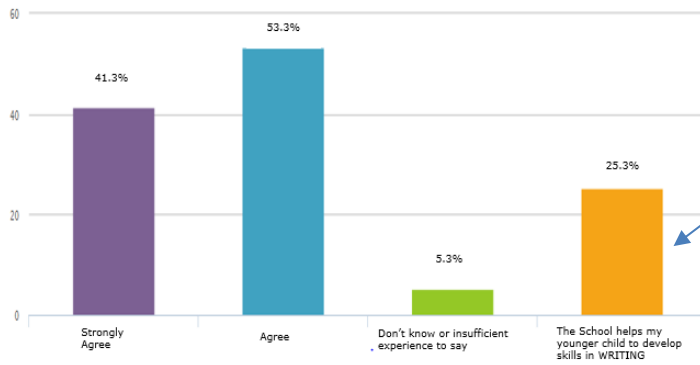

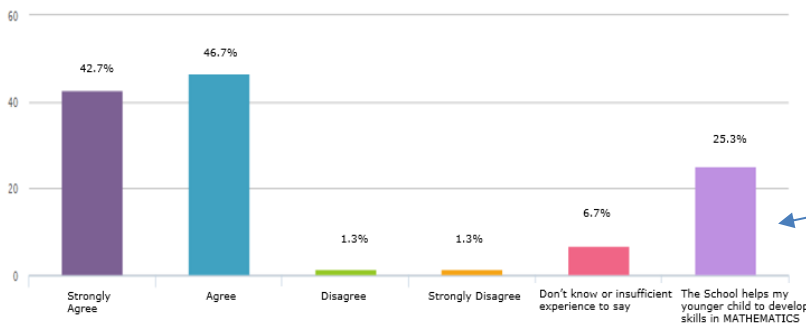

## 16. The School helps my older child develop skills in WRITING



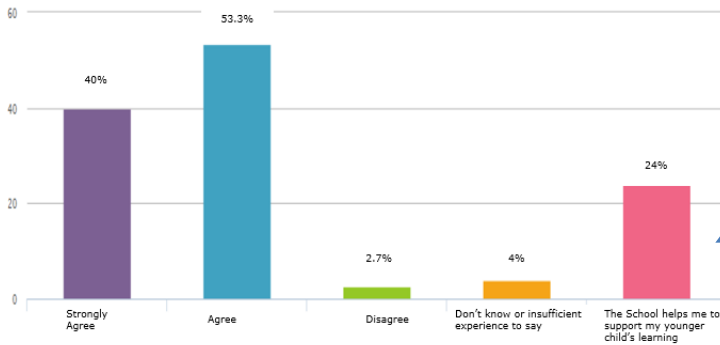

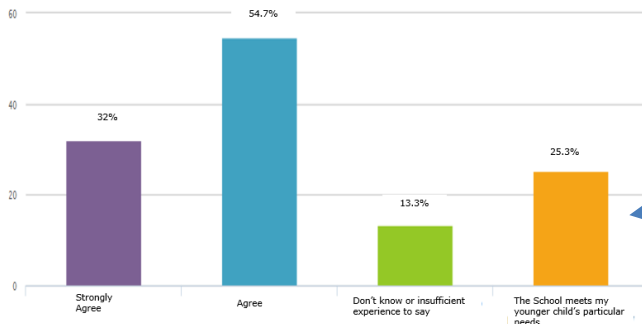

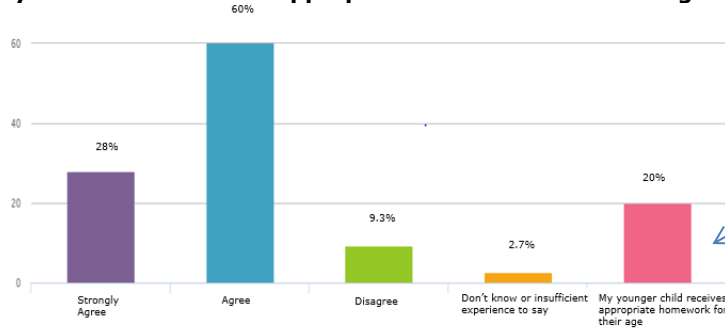

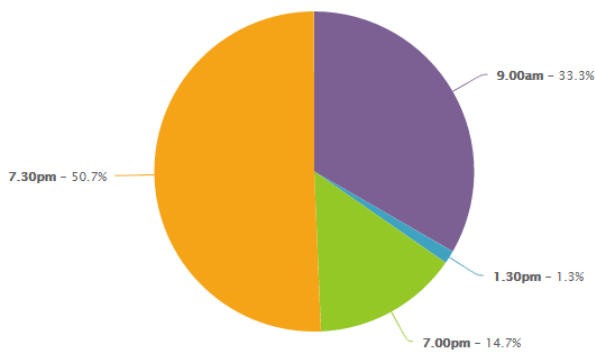
