Stay safe, keep healthy and care for others

On Friday 30 September the children and staff at Chestnut Lane School are spending their day thinking about the best ways to stay safe, keep healthy and care for people who are feeling unwell.

Activities will include learning how to bandage a wound, identifying risks to our safety in the environment, finding out the best way to wash your hands and lots of other fun tasks.

We will be using resources from the Red Cross and St John Ambulance alongside other teaching materials we already have in school.

Chestnut Lane School holds the Unicef Rights Respecting Level 2 award. Through this award we promote the rights of the child and so our special day will support the children to think about Article 24 'You have the right to the best health care possible, safe water to drink, nutritious food, a clean and safe environment, and information to help you stay well'.

We will also begin to make links with the orphanage in Thailand where Mrs Gossage will be volunteering for the charity CCD Thailand later this term. To help the workers in the orphanage provide the children with the same rights as our own children we would like to raise money for medical supplies and so ask if parents would make a minimum donation of £1 to support the charity this year. All donations should be given to the class teacher on the morning of 30 September.
