Dear Parents/Guardians

On Tuesday 3rd and Wednesday 4th October the Year Two children will be running a 'Harvest Café' for their parents. The café will be open in the afternoon from 2:15 –2:45pm on both days. Year Two parents and relatives are welcome. **Green Class will run the café on Tuesday for Red Class children and their parents. On Wednesday Red Class will run the café for Green Class children and their parents.**

Year Two children have been learning about harvest celebrations and 'Fairtrade'. We would like to place a focus this year on harvest in the UK. The children will cook food in advance to enjoy in the café. We would also like to ask parents to donate additional food and drink that have been harvested within the UK (where possible). Suitable suggestions include:

- Fruit juices or smoothies (no glass containers).
- Fresh fruit.
- Any wheat based breakfast goods, for example, savoury breads, fruit breads, pancakes etc.
- We cannot use any products which contain nuts.

Please note that we welcome any donations and would not turn away any food that has not been harvested within the UK.

We would hope to have enough food donated to serve in the cafe for both afternoons. Any products that would last can be brought into school from the morning of Tuesday 26th September onwards. Please can any fresh baked goods be brought in before 9.00am on the days that the café is running. There will be a table set up in the reception area where the food donated can be placed. Any goods left over at the end of the day will be sold off and money raised will go towards the chosen charity.

This year, we have chosen to raise money for NSPCC. We will therefore be asking for a minimum contribution of £1.00 when you enter the café. Funds raised will support children across the UK.

If you are a Year Two parent and would like to offer support by helping us in the café, please see your child's class teacher.
