


Remarkable Reading A Guide for KSI Parents/Guardians

How does the text measure up?

- My child could talk about how this book was organised (headings, contents, index etc.)

Decoding

Blending sounds to read new words, reading familiar words 'at a glance' & recognising 'tricky

- My child could tell me what happened at the beginning/middle/end.
- My child could retell the story/explain the information in his/her own words.
- After reading, my child enjoyed telling me about...
- My child described the main theme as...
- My child could blend sounds to read new words with support/independently.
- My child could read 'tricky words' with support/independently.
- My child checked his/her reading made sense/corrected his/her own reading.
- My child read fluently/confidently/with expression.
