<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u> <u>Addition</u></p> <p>Using the banana method or pictures (of tens and ones), have a go at adding two 2-digit numbers. Use examples like this: $32 + 45 =$ $41 + 52 =$</p> <p>For an extra challenge, add another calculation on the other side of the = sign like this: $32 + 14 = 24 + 22$</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u> <u>Subtraction</u></p> <p>Using the shopkeeper's method or pictures, have a go at subtracting a 2-digit number from another 2-digit number. Use example like this: $54 - 23 =$ $75 - 38 =$</p> <p>For an extra challenge, use the < > symbol to balance a calculation like this: $67 - 33 < 42 + 84$</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u> <u>Money</u></p> <p>Practise playing shops at home. Price up a set of objects.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use real coins to make amounts. Find more than one way of making each amount - Find change from £1 or £2. - Add totals together to find how much two or more items would cost to buy. 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u> <u>Shape</u></p> <p>Find a selection of objects.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sort them by shapes - Make a block graph or pictogram to show how many of each object you have - Compare the properties of them <p>Think about using vocabulary such as faces, edges and vertices.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u> <u>Character Description</u></p> <p>Create a wild and wonderful character based on somebody in your family.</p> <p>Make it as creative as possible!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Draw the character - Write descriptive sentences about their personality and appearance 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u> <u>Planning</u></p> <p>Plan a story about your new character. Make a comic strip outline the beginning (introduction of characters and setting), middle (problem) and ending (resolution to problem).</p> <p>Extra challenge: include key words and phrases that you'll use in your story.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u> <u>Story Writing</u></p> <p>Write the story about your new character.</p> <p>Show a clear beginning, middle and end.</p> <p>For an extra challenge, use your favourite phrases from other books you've read.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English/Science</u> <u>Non-Chronological Report</u></p> <p>Research plants and write a non-chronological report on them.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Title - Sub-headings - Photos/pictures and captions <p>For an extra challenge, include a quiz at the end!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u> <u>Weaving</u></p> <p>Use paper, ribbons, string or anything you can find to create a woven piece of art.</p> <p>Remember to stick the top bits down and Sellotape it to the table so it is secure.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u></p> <p>Illustrate the story you've written for English. Turn it into a book. Create a front cover.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u> <u>Continents</u></p> <p>Look at an image of a world map and create your own.</p> <p>This could be done through drawing, painting, on the computer or as collage.</p> <p>Label the 7 continents and 5 oceans.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Create a leaflet user guide for how to keep your body and mind healthy.</p>
